- Teachers get training from Rwanda Polytechnic which improves their teaching skills
- Collaboration with the Ministry of Education

- JAM's kitchen garden provides vegetables to the students
- Continued financial support to under privileged children who can not afford to pay tuition fees
- 99.5% pass rate in the 2018 national exams
- JAM Rwanda Vocation Training Centre (VTC) was chosen as one of the Rwanda Teacher Training Institute satellite sites for teacher training
